Dear School Community Members,

This is a brief letter to share some good news. Our attendance rate greatly improved this week while our quarantine and positive numbers dropped.

Last Friday our daily attendance was 83% with 17% or 222 students absent because of illnesses, quarantines or they were waiting for test results. With the change in our return to school practices and many negative test results, attendance improved to 93% this week. However, we are seeing a variety of illnesses out there like strep throat, colds and stomach bugs.

Our COVID-19 related absences dropped significantly. Please see the table and charts on the following pages. We hope that our school and community interventions will continue to help keep these numbers low.

Livingston County numbers are lower as well with 89 active cases (down from 124 last Friday and 14 in our zip code area (down from 23 last Friday). These numbers can fluctuate widely from week to week and don't necessarily indicate a trend but we remain hopeful that these are promising indications of better days ahead.

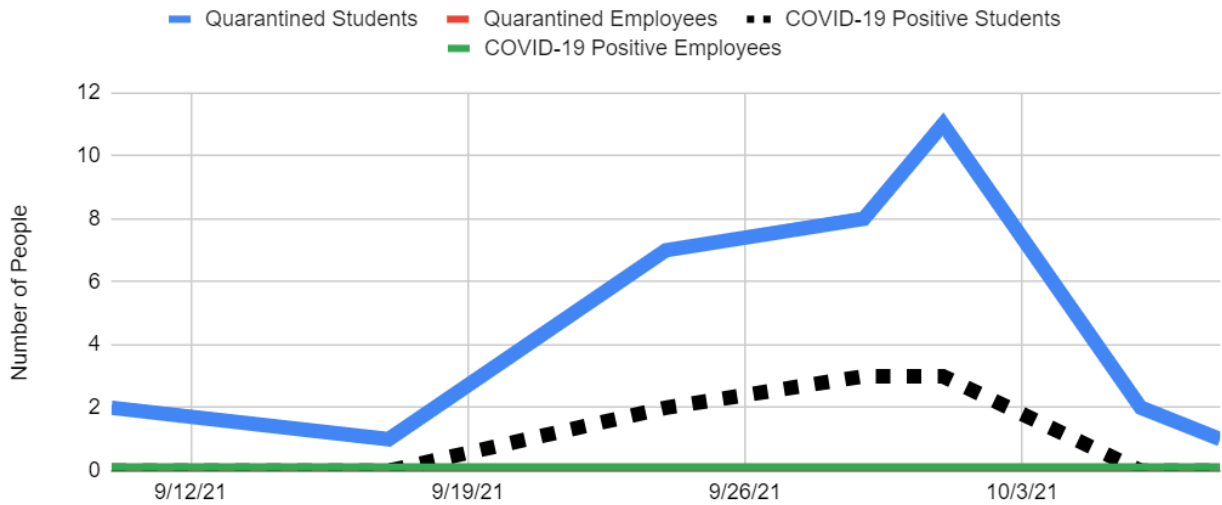

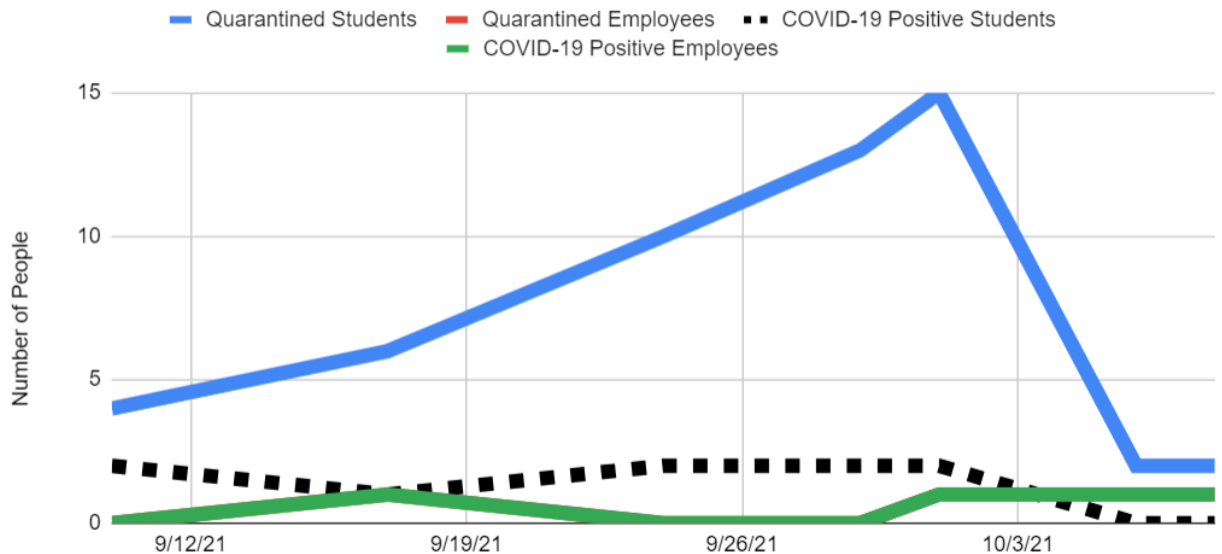

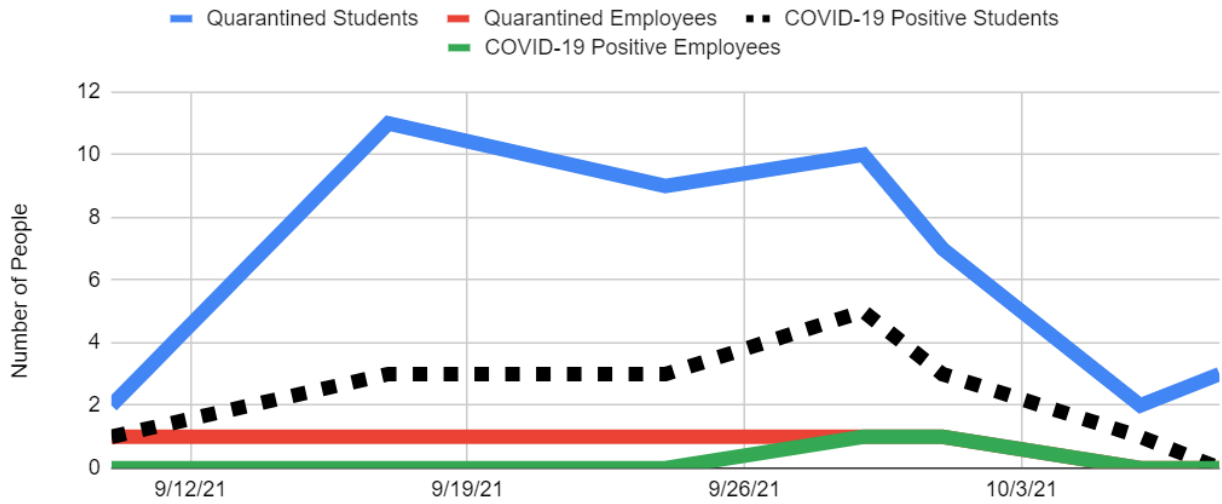
Dansville Primary School
