We are all eager to get things back to “normal”, but we still need to be diligent and help prevent the spread of illness at school, and prevent the sadness that occurs when we have to send children home.

If your child has a temperature of 100° F or higher **OR** if your child has **any one** of the symptoms below, then you must keep your child home. Please contact your family doctor if your child has symptoms. **A doctor's note and/or negative Covid test are still required to return to school.**

Fever/chills	Sore throat	Headache*	Fatigue*	Nasal congestion or runny nose*
New loss of taste or smell	Cough*	Shortness of breath*	Muscle or body aches	Nausea or vomiting or diarrhea*

*If this is a chronic condition as diagnosed by your child's doctor, then make sure that the school nurse has this documentation on file. We will not send children home who have symptoms that are chronic conditions if we have healthcare provider issued documentation and there are no additional new symptoms.
